



## Cambridge Journals Online- Quick Start Guide

Cambridge University Press publishes a prestigious list of scholarly journals, ranging across the humanities, social sciences and STM disciplines, made available electronically through the Cambridge Journals online service.

Please note that you will only be able to view the full text articles from journals that the Online Library has subscribed to. This guide will show you how to make sure your search results only contain subscribed content.

If you need help while using the database click on 'Help' in the top right hand corner of the screen.

**Browsing-** browsing can be a useful alternative to searching as it gives you an overview of the subject content of the database. If you only want to view full text journals select 'Browse journals by subscribed content.'

### Guide to Browsing Cambridge Journals Online

Select the option you want from the drop down menu.

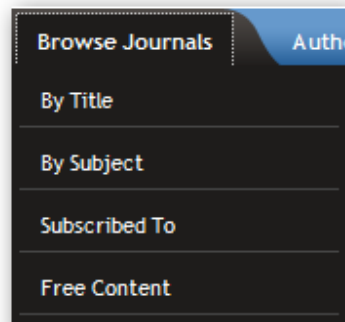
**By Title-** This feature allows you to browse through the entire list of Cambridge Journals alphabetically. You can either scroll down the list or click on the appropriate letter at the top of the page. Clicking on a journal title will take you to the journal homepage. \*

**By Subject-** All available subjects are listed at the top of the page. Click on a subject to see the list of journals Cambridge publishes in that field.

**Subscribed To-** This is the list of all the journals that we have **full text** access to.

**Free Content-** Enables you to view journal articles that are freely available.

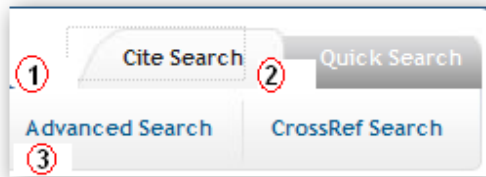
\*If you find a journal we do not subscribe to go back to the Online Library site and check the Full Text Electronic Database list as it may be in another Online Library database.

## Searching



**1. Cite Search**- If you have details of a journal article you want to find enter the information into the relevant fields.

**2. Quick Search**- Type your search topic into the box and click search. This will find all the articles with your search terms in but not all of them will be full text. If you find something that is not full text go back to the Online Library site and perform a Summon search to check whether it is in another database.

We would recommend that you click on 'Search All Journals Only' as we do not subscribe to any E-books from Cambridge journals.

Enter your search terms in the boxes under 'Search for' (1), you can create complex searches by joining your search terms together using the operators on the right hand side (2). Use the 'Search On' (3) fields to change the focus of your search. For example if you look for your search terms in the whole text of the article, you might find you have too many results so you could then perform the search again but changing it to search on 'abstract'. This would narrow the focus of your search. For further assistance with this please look on the Cambridge Journals help pages under 'Advanced Search'.

## Advanced Search-Continued

Search Reset

1. **Journals-** The default setting is to search all the journals so use this field to narrow the search to specific journals.
2. **By Date-** This limits the search by publication date, the example above would retrieve the most recent articles on a topic (at the time of writing this guide!)
3. The Miscellaneous menu allows you to remove different types of content from the search. **To only search journals we have subscribed to, make sure that 'Only search journals you have full access to' is selected.**

**4. Specific Article Type-** Allows you to restrict the article types to be displayed by choosing from a drop-down menu.


**Fields to Be Returned** - allows you to choose from a drop-down menu which fields you would like displayed on the search results page.
